

Class of 2020 TFTGC College Scholarship Program



Graduating high school seniors are invited to apply for a college scholarship (up to \$1,000). Applicants must be eligible based on criteria listed below. Scholarships will be awarded depending on involvement within The First Tee as well as video quality as decided by a panel of staff and board members.

CRITERIA

Applicant must:

1. be an active participant in TFTGC programs at the Birdie, Eagle, or Ace level (taken part in at least one 8-week session in the last calendar year)
2. be an active TAC member and/or volunteer of 10+ hours per year at the chapter
3. have secured enrollment (proof of acceptance and commitment required) to a vocational, military, associate, or bachelor program for Fall 2020
4. require financial assistance and submit a statement of how funds will be used
5. create a compelling 3-5 minute video (criteria and guideline below)

Video Criteria & Guidelines:

1. Name, age, and length of time involved at The First Tee
2. Favorite Core Value and how that core value has helped you:
 - a. during a critical or difficult in your time (explain in detail) and/or
 - b. grow as a person (explain in detail)
3. Most-used Life Skill and how that life skill has helped you:
 - a. during a critical or difficult in your time (explain in detail) and/or
 - b. grow as a person (explain in detail)

(Remember, there is a difference between Core Values and Life Skills.)
4. How has The First Tee impacted your life (explain in detail)
5. Most memorable The First Tee experience and what you learned from that experience
6. How you will use what you learned at The First Tee throughout your future, after you graduate from the program
7. If you were sitting in front of supporters/donors, what would you tell them to influence them to support The First Tee
(Please do not answer each question by stating the question first, then your answer – we want your stories to flow together as one cohesive piece on video.)

Please submit by mail or email no later than the deadline dates below:

1. 3-5 minute video, answering all "Video Criteria" questions – *due January 13, 2020*
2. Statement of use of funds – *due January 13, 2020*
3. Fall 2019 school/program enrollment proof – *due May 1, 2020*
